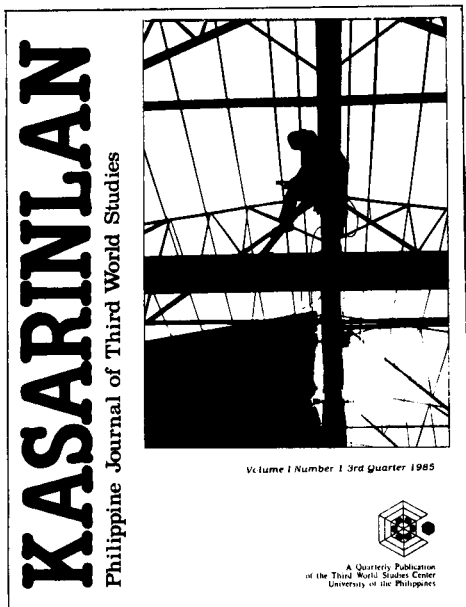


ERRATUM
